I have had the distinct pleasure of serving as Robert Cawson's principal and supervisor for almost three years, and is my honor to write this letter of recommendation for him. In the fall of 2016 Robert was hired as a fifth grade teacher at Glencairn Elementary School. Robert immediately stood out as an individual with tremendous integrity and character.
